## Project Example: Allenton Library – Outdoor resource

Derby Community Payback team has organised work at the library to change a derelict piece of land outside into a useable area for the community.

The land was cleared of rubbish and weeds and then landscaped the plot with paving slabs, raised flower beds and benches.

The area by the library is now a useful resource accesible by all including wheelchair users.

There will be an Open Day at the library in June 2010 to officially recognise the transformation of this previously unuseable area of land.
